1) KERES CLASSIC OPEN A & B – July 27th – August 1st 2026

System: Two separate tournaments: Classic Open A (FIDE rating 1900+) and Classic Open B (FIDE rating -2000). The organizer can allow a few exceptions while making sure that achieving title norms is still possible. If a player qualifies for both events by rating, please add your choice during the registration. Both tournaments will have 9 rounds in Swiss system with the same schedule.

Time control: 90 minutes for the game; 30 seconds added per move from move 1
The default time is 15 minutes.

Prizes: **Classic Open A:** I place - **2500€**, II place - **1800€**, III place - **1400€**, IV place - **1000€**, V place - **700€**, VI place - **500€**, VII place - **300€**, VIII place - **200€**,
Women: I place -**500€**, II place -**300€**, III place- **200€**; best Estonian player and Estonian woman -**150€** (in case does not already receive a main or women prize); 50+ -**175€, 150, 125**, women 50+ **150**, best rating (-2100) -**150€**, U20 **150€**, best U18 and best G18 -**150€**

Classic Open B: I place - **500€**, II place - **400€**, III place - **300€**, IV place - **200€**; V place - **100€**
women: I place -**100€**, best 65+ ja 50+ - **100€**, best rating (1500; without rating) -**75€**, best youth and girls(U14, U10, U8) - **prize for the value of 75€ each**,

Extra: **10 GM/WGM titled (rated at least 2500+/2300+) foreign players can be offered free accommodation from the organizers based on agreements made before the festival. GM-titled players rated 2600+ as of 1.07.2026 will be accommodated at the ESTONIA Resort Hotel & Spa**

2) KERES MEMORIAL BLITZ TOURNAMENT - August 1st 2026

System: 11 rounds Swiss system, FIDE-rated

Schedule: **August 1st at 16.30, registration until 16.00** (all players who haven't confirmed their registration by 16 will not be paired in for the 1st round)

Time control: 3 min for the game + 2 sec per move

Prizes: I place **350€**, II place **200€**, III place **150€**, IV place **100€**

Special prizes: women **100€**; 65+ and 50+ **75€**; U18 **50€**; Pärnu **50€**; Pärnu youth **50€**

Special awards: youth/girls/Pärnumaa (U16, U14, U12, U10)

3) KERES MEMORIAL RAPID TOURNAMENT - August 2nd 2026

System: 9 rounds Swiss system, FIDE-rated

Schedule: **August 2nd at 10.30, registration until 10.15** (all players who haven't confirmed their registration by 10.15 will not be paired in for the 1st round)

Time control: 12 min for the game + 3 sec per move

Prizes: I place **500€**, II place **350€**, III place **250€**, IV place **150€**

Special prizes: women **100€**; U20 **100€**, U18 **75€**; G18 **75€**; 65+ and 50+ **100€, 75€, 75+ 100€**,

Pärnu **75€**; Pärnu youth **75€**

Special awards: youth/girls/Pärnumaa (U16, U14, U12, U10)

NB! GM above 2450 and WGM above 2250 free participation if registered before 31.05

If the participant withdraws from the competition after paying the fee but before the 27th of June, the organizer will pay back 50% of the fee. Later withdrawals will not be paid back. The organizers leave themselves the right to reject participation while explaining the reasons to the participant in a written format.

Tie-breaks: 1) Median Bucholtz (-1 weakest; 2) Median Bucholtz (-2 weakest); 3) more wins with Black pieces

Sharing prizes: **Classic Opens' monetary prizes - Horti system; rapid and blitz – prizes are not shared**; every player can receive one prize per competition; special prizes awarded if there are at least 5 players in the group; the taxes will be withheld according to Estonian law.

Classical (Title + Elo), rapid and blitz prize funds will be guaranteed in case of at least 100 participants
If the participant is not present at the closing ceremony and does not inform the organizer beforehand, the prize will not be given out.
